A- Introduction

RBR-World is a rally simulator based and implemented on the Richard Burns Rally Game; the modifications done by the RBR-World A.S.D. Association and the Crew of the website RBR-World.com are likely to change the way the game runs, the graphics and the sounds. The purpose of the association and the simulator is to have fun and to make the users have fun, organizing online competitions and events during the fair and expo events all around Italy. RBR-World is an hobby made by people that in their spare time make group together, trying to share their passion about rally: continue to keep it as it is and remember, you are the masters of your destiny.

B - Association RBR-World A.S.D.

1 – To participate completely to the life of the RBR-World.com website, the user will need to subscribe to the association instituted by RBR-World. The statute of the association describes the rules and the steps needed by the user to subscribe and actively participate to the initiatives of the association, including the organized championships and the beneficence events. The subscription has an yearly validity (social year is from September 1

st

to August 31

st

) and will include the whole period during wich the championships will be held.

2 – The user willing to run the championships organized by RBR-World will need to subscribe and accept the association statute, verify and confirm during the association process that the site, forum, Richard Burns Rally game and RBR-World utility are working fine using the tick required by the form.

3 – The association requires a payment: this allows to maintain the site and the servers that host our platform and to give some money in donation to who is not as lucky as we are.

The payment methods for the 2015 are:Paypal or wire transfer.

The amount for the associative year 2017 (september 2016-august 2017) is € 24,16.

4 -The account created and the subscription is personal, it is not possible to give the subscription or the account to a third part.

5- The membership of the association involves the agreement of this rulebook, the forum rulebook, the community and the statute of the association RBR-World.com.



6- The administration of RBR-World has the right to accept or deny the subscription of an user to the association and the participation of the championships, even without giving explanation about the denial.

C - Career Mode

1- The performance of the driver in a certain amount of races and in a determined amount of time. The last 25 races (that were valid for the ranking) driven by the driver will be the only evaluating factor of the value inside the championships organized by RBR-World.

2 – The driver's performances will be defined by the ranking number, as indicated in point 1. This value is estimated with an algorithm that calculates the performance every time you participate in a rally (not a rally free). The ranking can be increased if you did great performances or decreased if they are not as high as they should be with that car, in that championship or rally you run.

3 – The ranking will define the part of members that you will race against, even if this will not bound you to any car or class or championship.

4 – During the progress of the free championships proposed, every driver will be allowed to race any series or trophy organized by RBR-World with any car released in the utility available in that championship.

In series that have restricted entries, the driver will be allowed to race with any car available according to the personal Ranking level and his budget of \$R credits.

The participation of a driver to the championships with restrictions is bounded to specific features of the series.

D - Competitions

1- Inside the RBR-World.com site you will find two different types of championships: Free Mode and Career Mode.

2- The Free Mode, reserved to the users that have subscribed a membership on RBR-World.com, is a free participation way of racing to all the championships proposed, with any car. No restrictions will be made in this mode, you will just have to subscribe via the driver panel.

3- Still in development, the Experimental Career Mode will have small appearance during this year, being used in small championships or trophies, where some requirements will need to be met by drivers to enter.

E - Races and championship execution

Rally live

Event run live, following the roadbook; The driver must follow the schedule and the times of the race

Rally open time

Event run in a certain period of time, you don't need to follow times of the roadbook; Only limits are the time of opening and closing of the race.

Rally open time short

Events similar to open time rally, but shorter in time.

4

Rally Mix

Mixed events, usually two legs divided in Live and Open time.

3 – The championships races may be of one leg or more. The one leg races (both live and open time) have only one roadbook, shown in the moment of the opening of the race.

The races with 2+ legs, will have a public roadbook shown in the moment of the opening of the roadbook relative to the leg in progress. The time used by drivers to run the stages will be added stage by stage in every leg.

4 – The subscription to the championships, single races, particular events etc will be done only using the driver panel on RBR-World.com site.

5 – The SuperRally is the possibility for the driver to come back racing after his retire on a Special Stage. The system will add to the overall time of the driver some imposed times, according to the number of the stages not driven by the user. The re-enter of the race will be in the successive service park. In a 2+ Legs rally, the retire in the last sector the first leg, will not exclude the user from leg 2. In 2+ Legs rallies, the SuperRally is available only in the first leg. 6

– In the championships rallies you will find the Power Stage: this is usually the last stage of a rally or a leg and it allows to earn points for the classification of the championship.

F - Championship and Trophies

1- The championships and trophies will take place from November 2016 to July 2017. Take a look at the Calendar paragraph for details.

: starts in Open Time, roadbook opening and start of the race thursday 8:00AM, closing of the leg 11.00PM of monday; LEG 2 is a Live race, on Tuesday, roadbook opens at 9:00PM (GMT+1) and race starts at 9.15PM.

::roadbook opening at 8:00 AM of day1, closing at 11:00PM of day2

-During the championships, the driver will be able to discard the worse result in the championship: without communication from the driver, we will discard the worse result.

7- The administration reserves the right to change the period during which the championships will be held, giving communication in advance to the members of the association.

– National Championships on request

1 - Any associated with RBR-World A.S.D. can require the opening of a national championship, organized directly by the association, not counted in the number of championships that a pilot can race within their competitive season.

2 – Each associated can take part only in the national championship of his own country. This championship, will be created and organized with a minimum of subscriptions of 20 requests.

3 - The request must be sent to the administration privately, to the mail: info@rbr-world.com

4 - In the request, the following features must be specified: - League Name. - The duration of the championship duration (following the calendar in Section 6). - The mode of the championship (Live or Open Time). - Days on which will be race the championship (following the calendar in Section 6). - Number of races scheduled (minimum 6, maximum 9). - Dates of the competition (following the calendar in Section 6). - Definition of the classes and eligible cars. - Possible annexed trophy to the championship.

5 - The RBR-World authority reserves the right to accept or not the competition depending on the reasons described below: - League name not appropriate. (Name already exists or not well adapted to rallying). - Duration of championship not appropriate. (Example: pushing the limits of membership). - Number of races not appropriate. (There are only two methods of execution). - Contract Number objectionable material (Maximum 8 for league games). - Dates and days not appropriate to the championship (Tuesday and Thursday of the live races can not be other races in that mode. Excessive Open Time races). - Classes and cars admitted not appropriate. (Class or group does not exist in current landscape of RBR-World). The administration of RBR-World reserves the right to accept or less a competition, according to the number of proposed championships.

I - Pilots

1 - Each pilot can run 3 senior Championships free mode among 5 proposed, can run all the trophies and all leagues career mode offered by experimental directors of RBR-World, with any car within the utility, in accordance with the limitations for classes and Championship competition mode choice from it, which will match certain regulations.

2 - The driver can affiliate to a team, by his own will, the only difference between private and factory driver is that the driver in a team has the help of the rest of the team and lives a more "social" way of racing.

3 - The common sense is mandatory for a driver in an online competition like this. Being correct is the first fundamental thing of a user/driver, being him a veteran or a newbie.

4 - Possible sanction to the drivers are decided by the administration, evaluating the "offense".

5 - The driver is obliged to keep the replays of all the stages of the race for 3 days after the end of it

L - Team

1 - A team inside RBR-World.com is a group of drivers that participate to the life of the site and community, running championships in the career mode, having the same target of having fun and race together.

2 - Teams are composed by a minimum of 5 users, subscribed to the RBR-World association. The maximum number is 15 drivers.

3 - There might be "Satellite Team" which will be administrated by the Team Manager of the primary team. Satellite Team must have name, logo and livery different from the main team.

4 - To build a team, the user will have to send his request to the administration with the "Team Panel" inside the "Driver Panel".

5 - When the team is approved by the RBR-World administration and crew and created, the TM or Vice-TM will be able to request to opening of the private forum, for the members of the team. 6 - Teams are not allowed in career mode.

7 - Where team standing is allowed, will be the first 6 drivers of the team to take that ranking points. Will no longer be as in previous years, that all pilots participants to a league game take points for the team standings.

M - Protests and Checks

1 - The judge and decision by the Administration of the Race Director (DG) and the crew are FINAL.

2 - Every driver will be able to ask for the check of one or more stages of other drivers but he will need to provide his own replay of the same stages. The request will be between the driver and the Race Director, other protest ways will not be considered. An user has 3 protest to be issued during the whole year. This to avoid too many protests, even when there is no need to do it.

3 - The Race Director has the power to verify and control replay, setup and race behaviour of any driver during any races, from rally free to championships races. Even for driver that retires during the race.

4 - The communications from the RD and for the RD will be done with the form inside the Driver Panel, Private messages on RBR-World.com site or email provided at the subscription of the site.

5 - In the event of irregularities the driver will be "deleted" from the race (retired on PS1, 0 points, -2.00 Ranking for that race.). In more serious events, the driver may lose championship points and/or may be excluded from



one or more races of the championships.

6- The control of the RD will extend also to the events that are not part of championships. In the event of irregularities, the sanctions will be the impossibility to access future races or the suspension of the account of the driver. 7- The final response of the check will be communicated as soon as possible, being it positive or negative.

N - Other

1- The administration and the crew reserves the right to modify this rulebook in any moment, whereas a not-solvable problem shows up.

2 – Every try to change the utility of RBR-World, change the values of the own or others profile, in the aim to change the results of races and championships will be punished according to the gravity of the infraction. The sanction may be: ban of the account and deleting of all the data of the driver, suspension of the account for a limited amount of time, loss of ranking points, lock for a limited amount of time of the ranking points.

3 – Every user must have only one account at his disposal. Double or more profiles will be deleted after the communication. If more users drive from the same place (same PC or same internet line) you have to communicate it to RBR-World administration. 4 - According to the economical disposal of the association, at the end of the year, we will give prizes to the winners of the championships. These prizes will be communicated around the end of the associative year from the administration.
